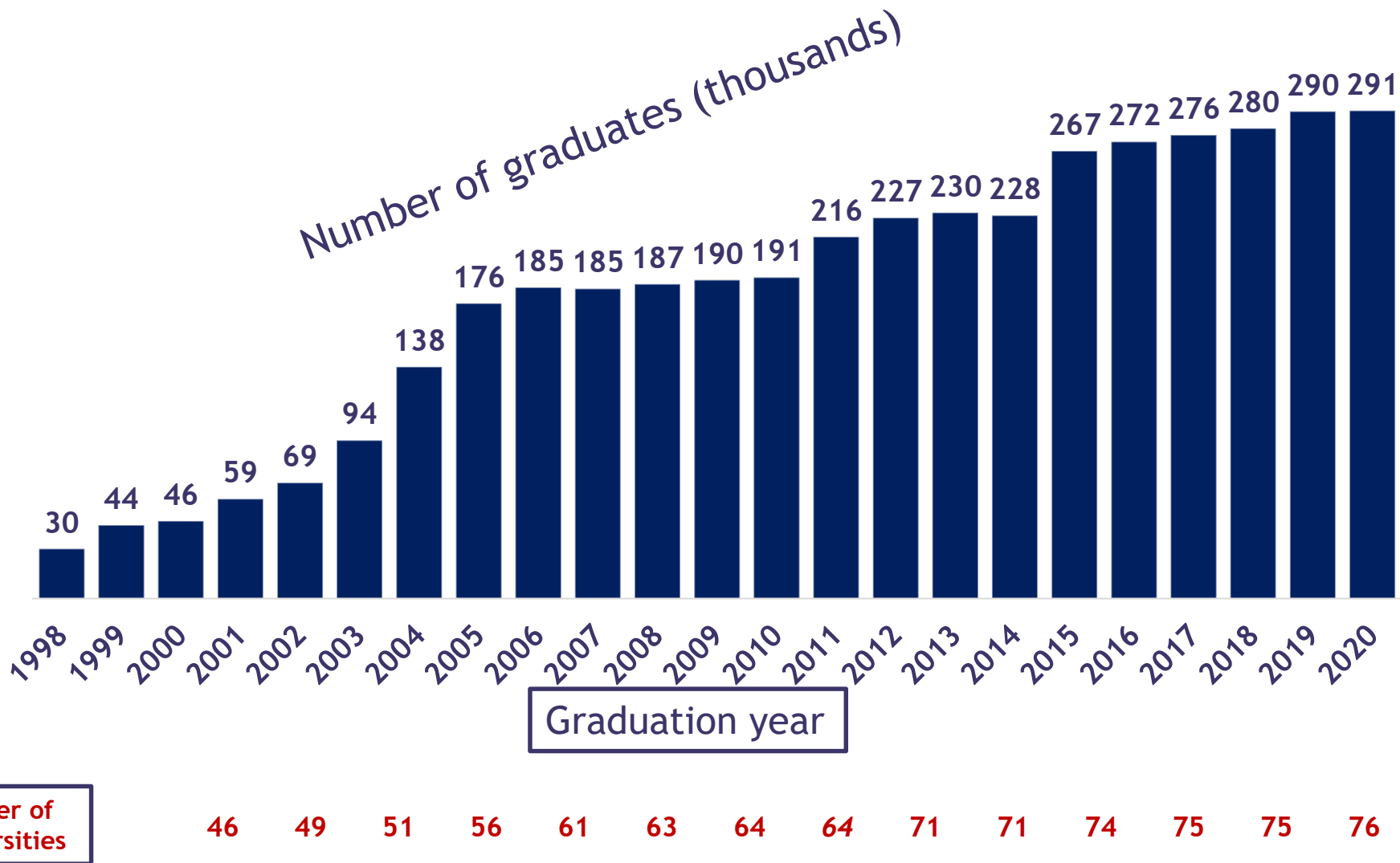

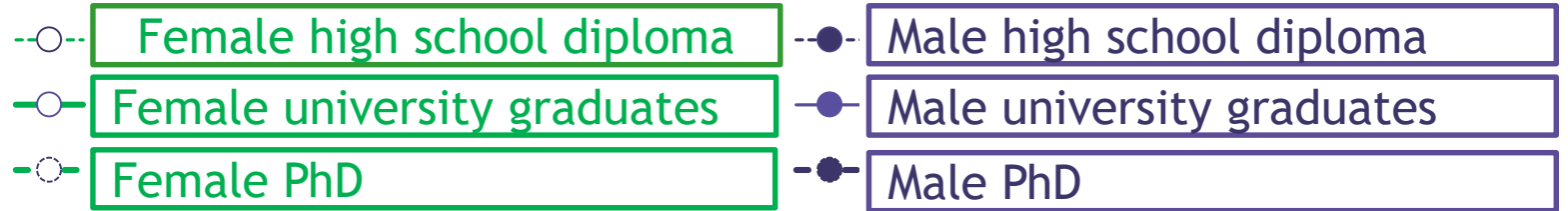


Number of graduates and universities/graduation year 1998-2020 (absolute value)

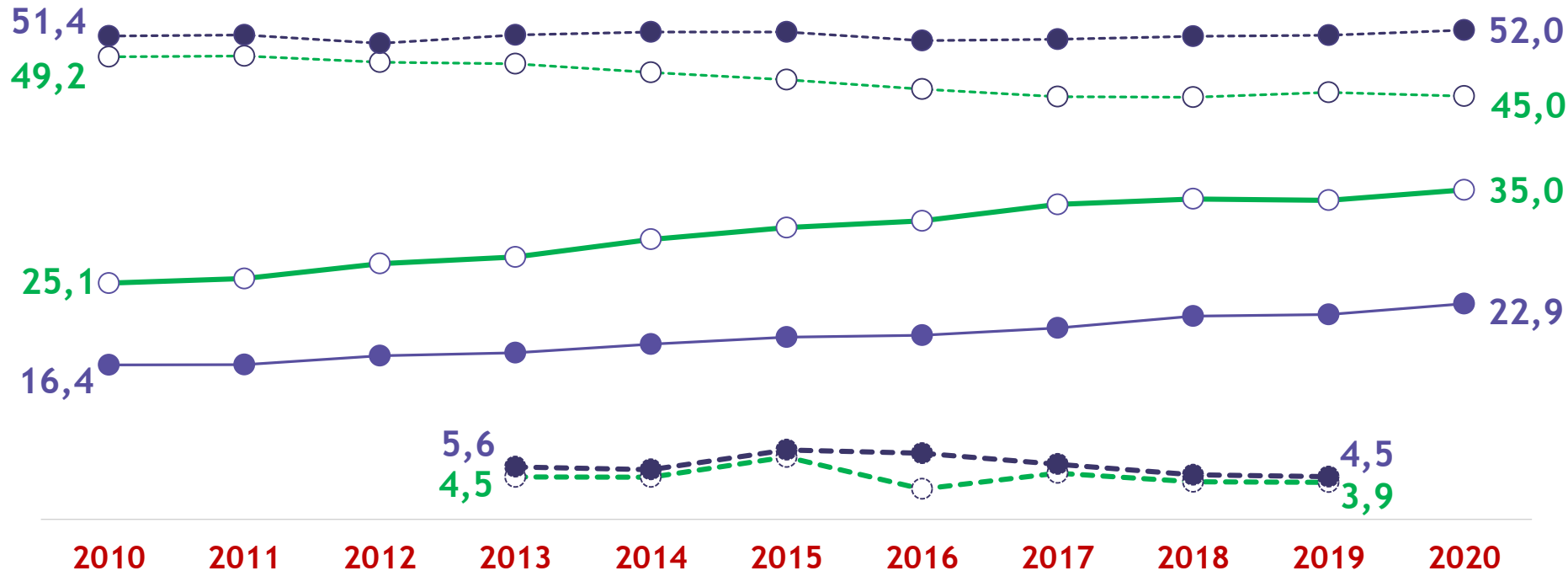




High school diploma, University graduates, PhD (25-34 years old)

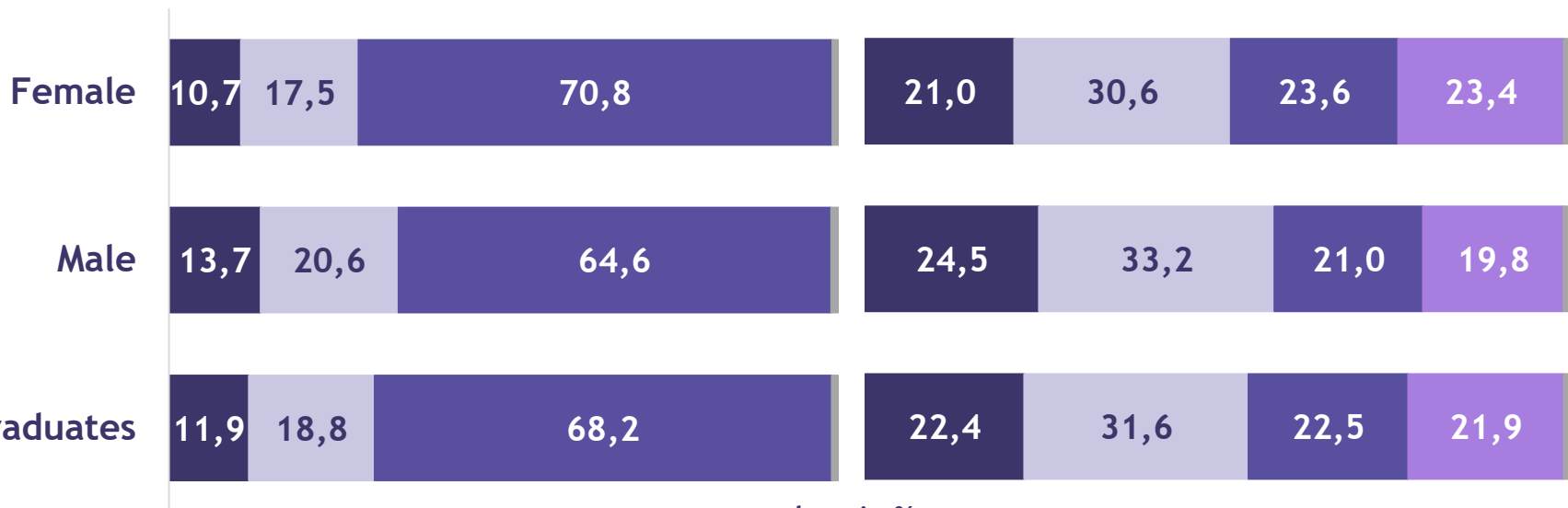

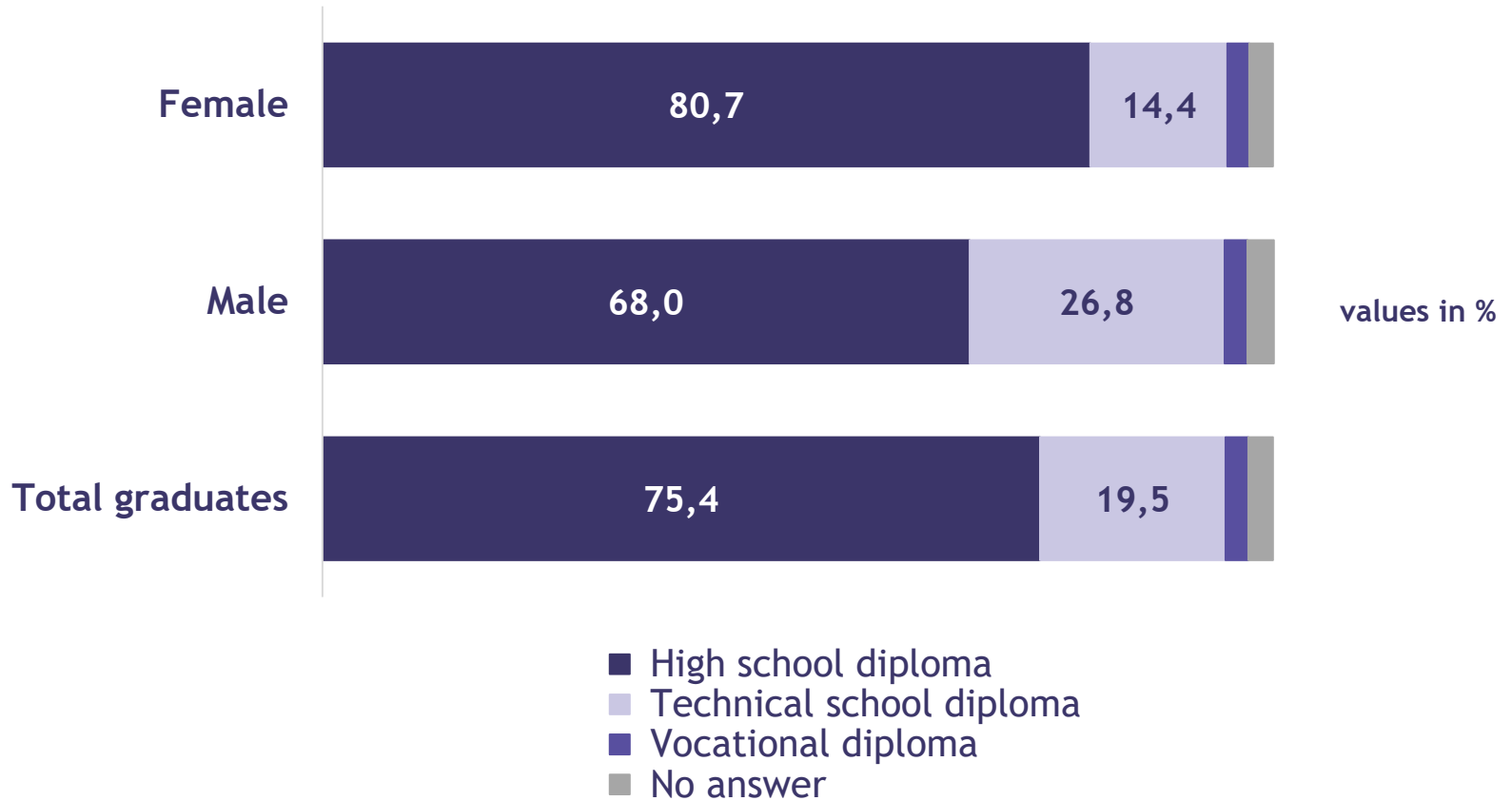

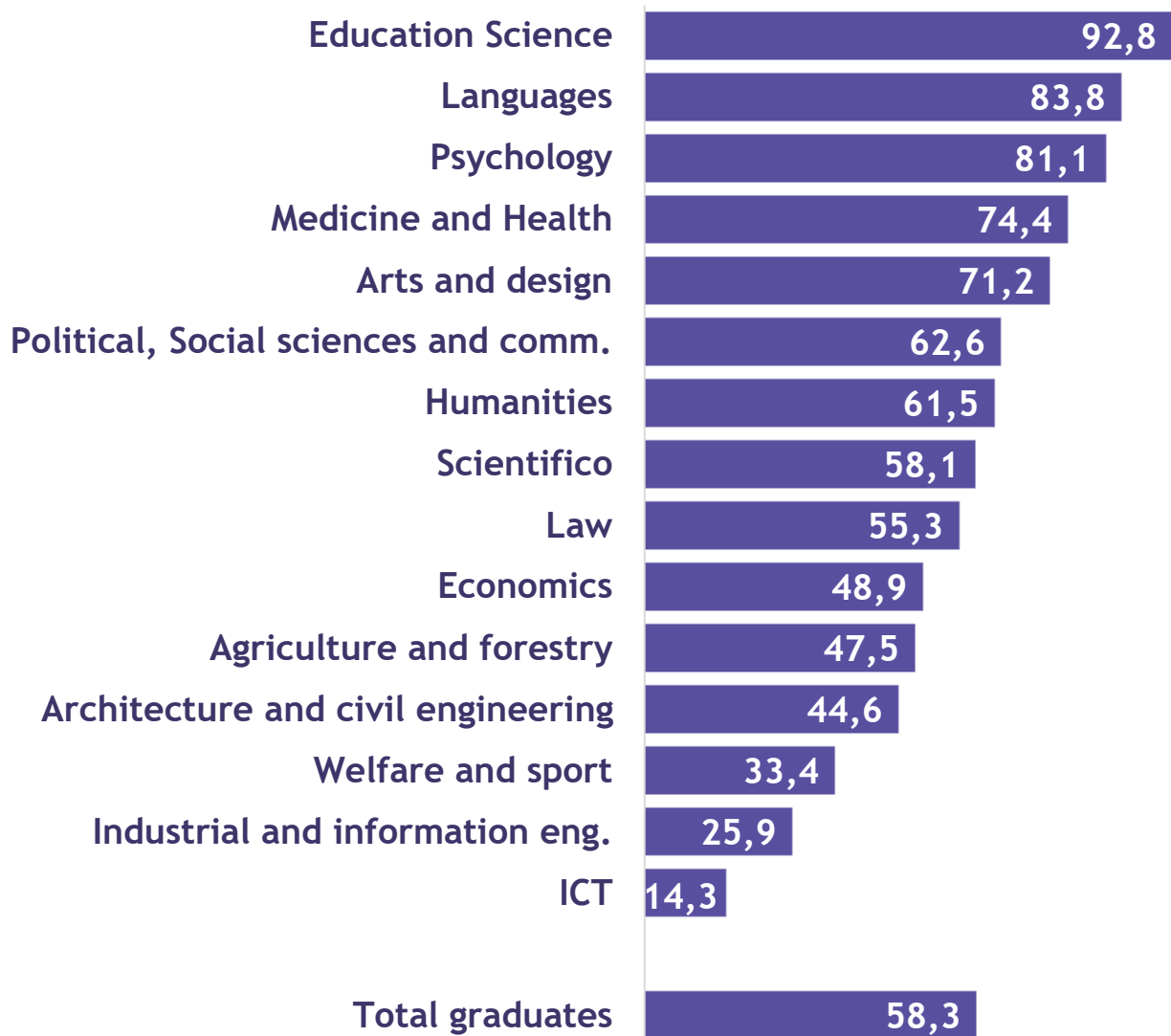


High school diploma type (2020 graduates)



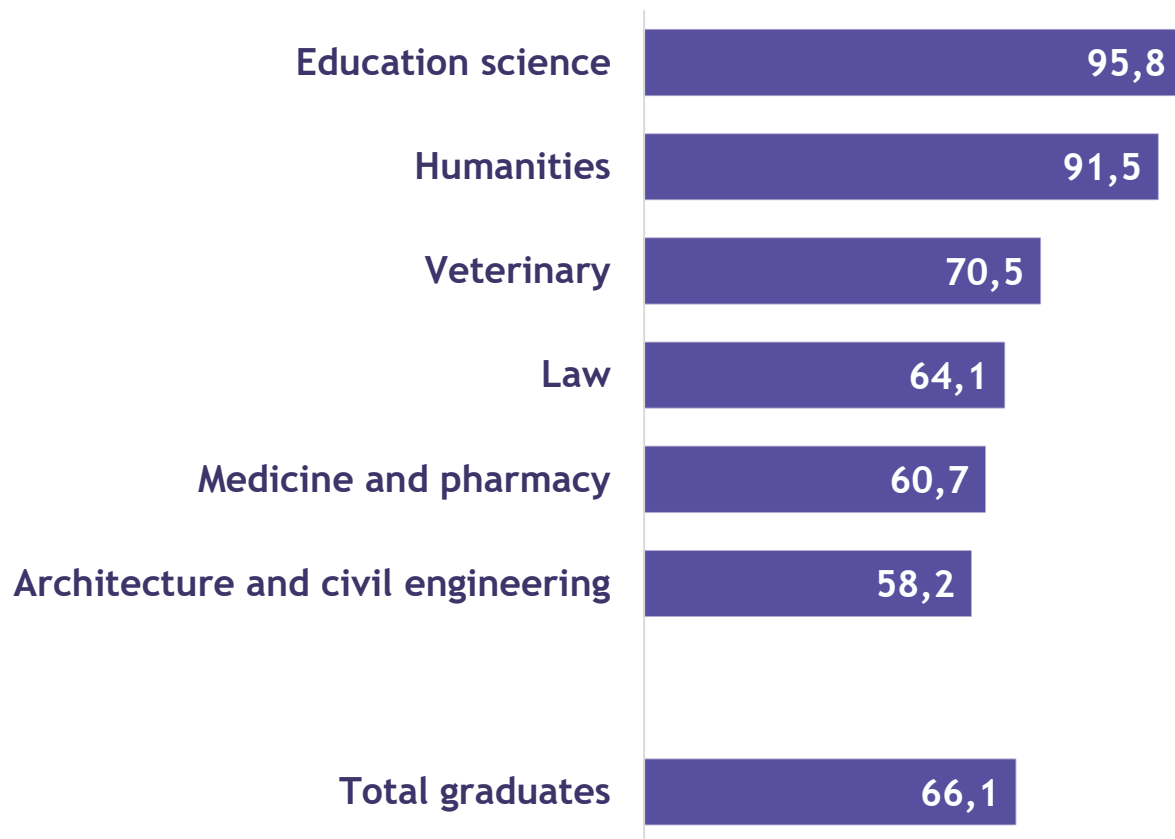


2020 female graduates in % by field of study - bachelor



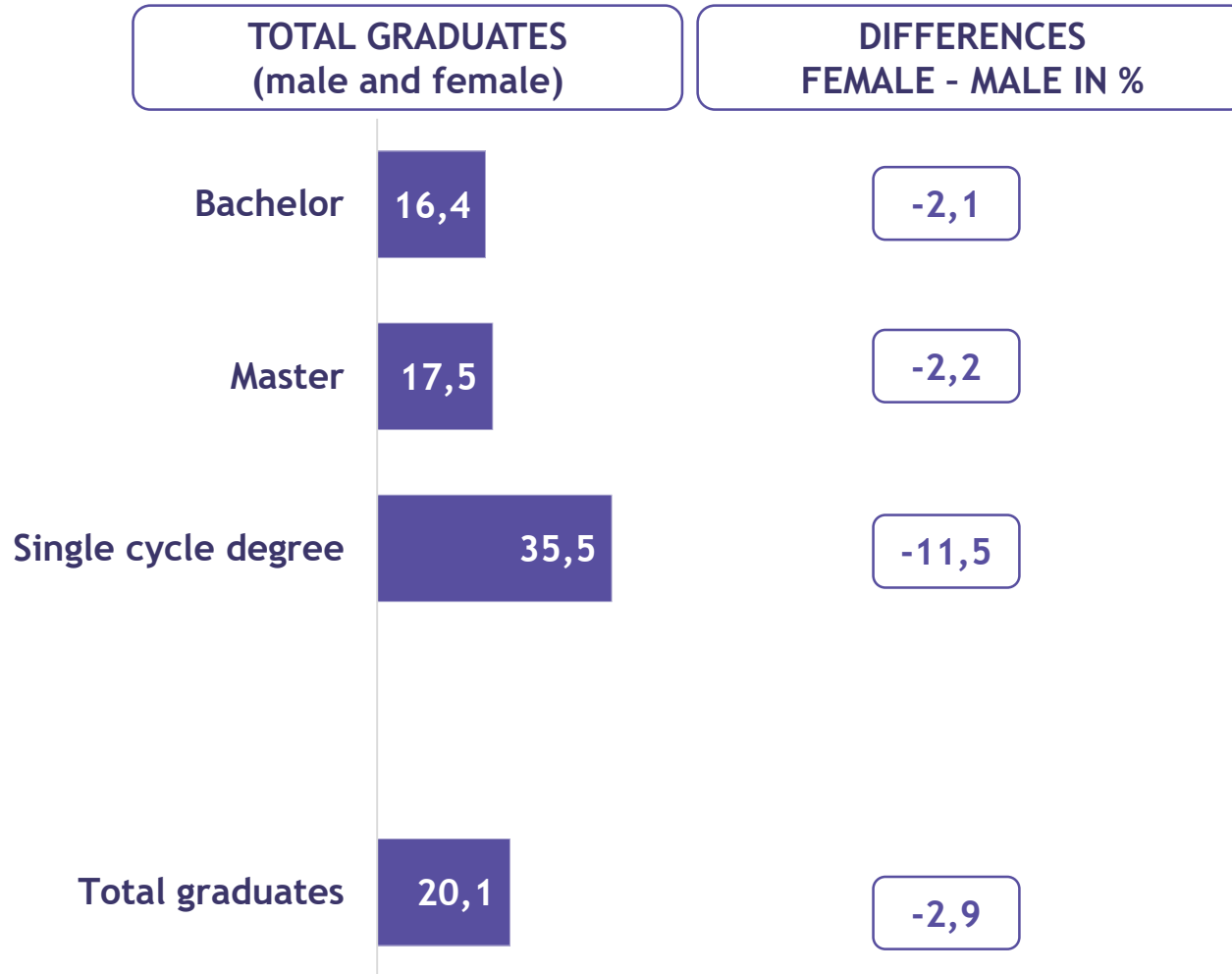


2020 female graduates in % by field of study - single cycle



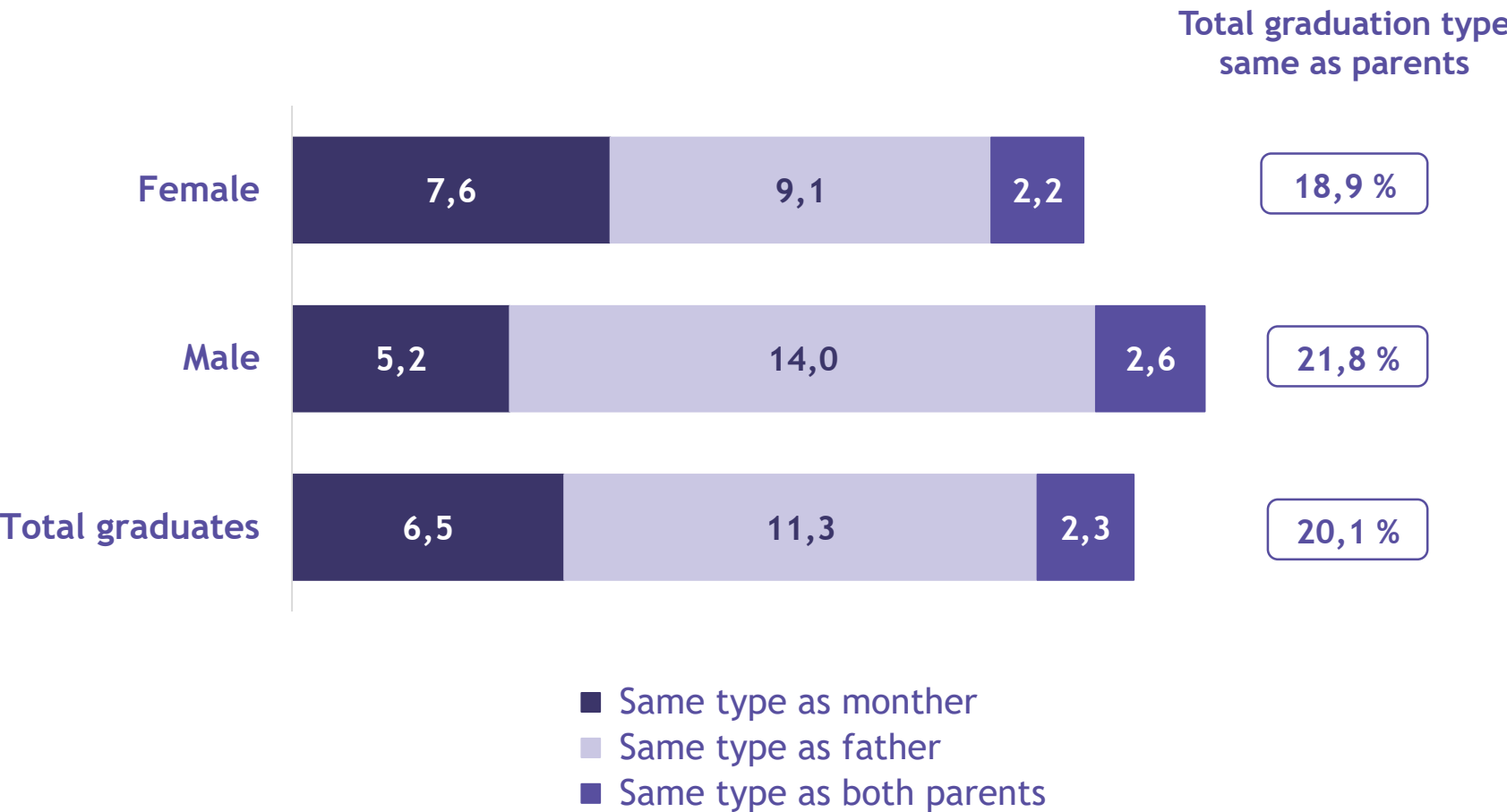


Same graduation type as one of the parents



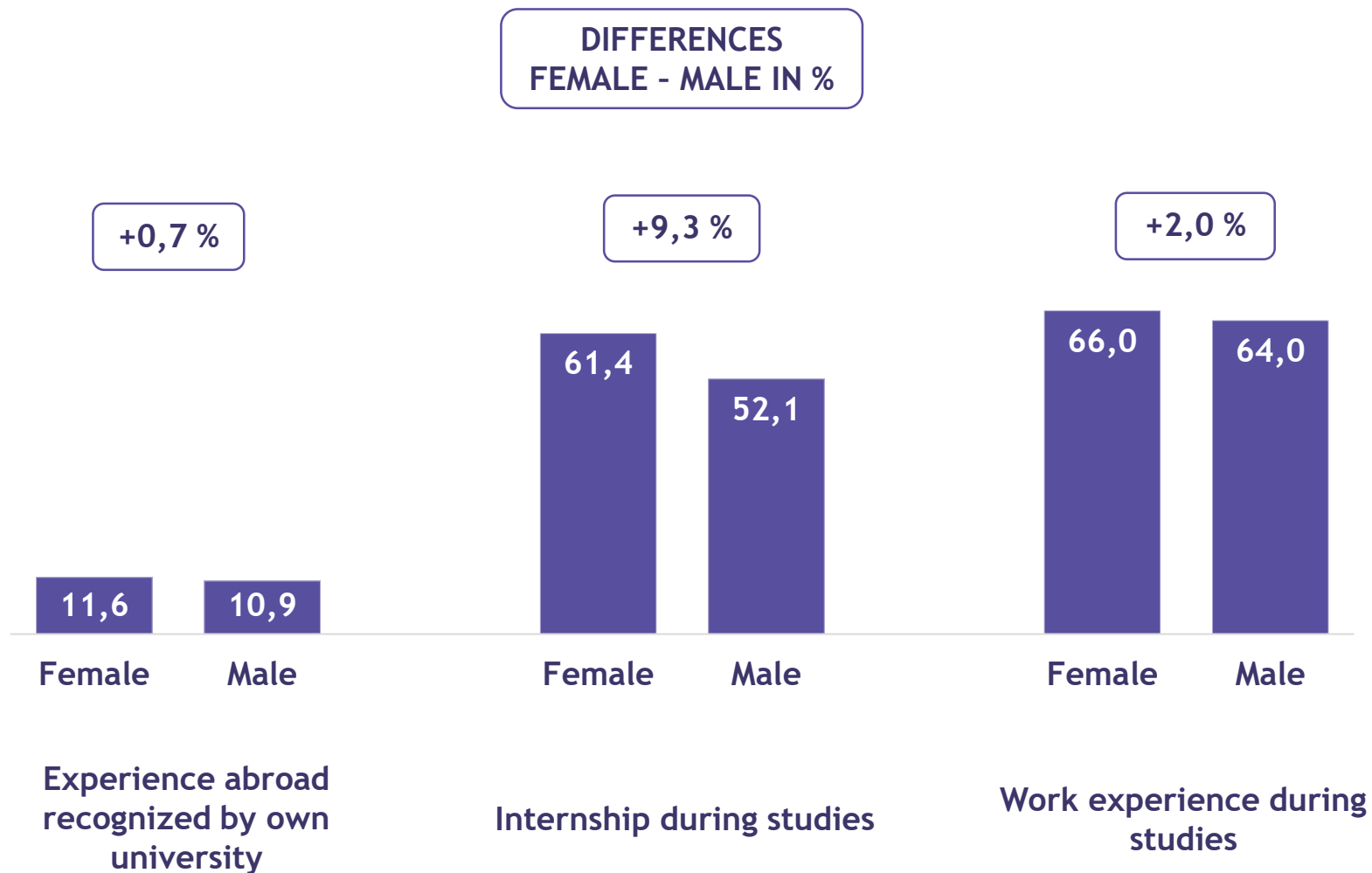


Graduation type inheritance (same as one or both parents)



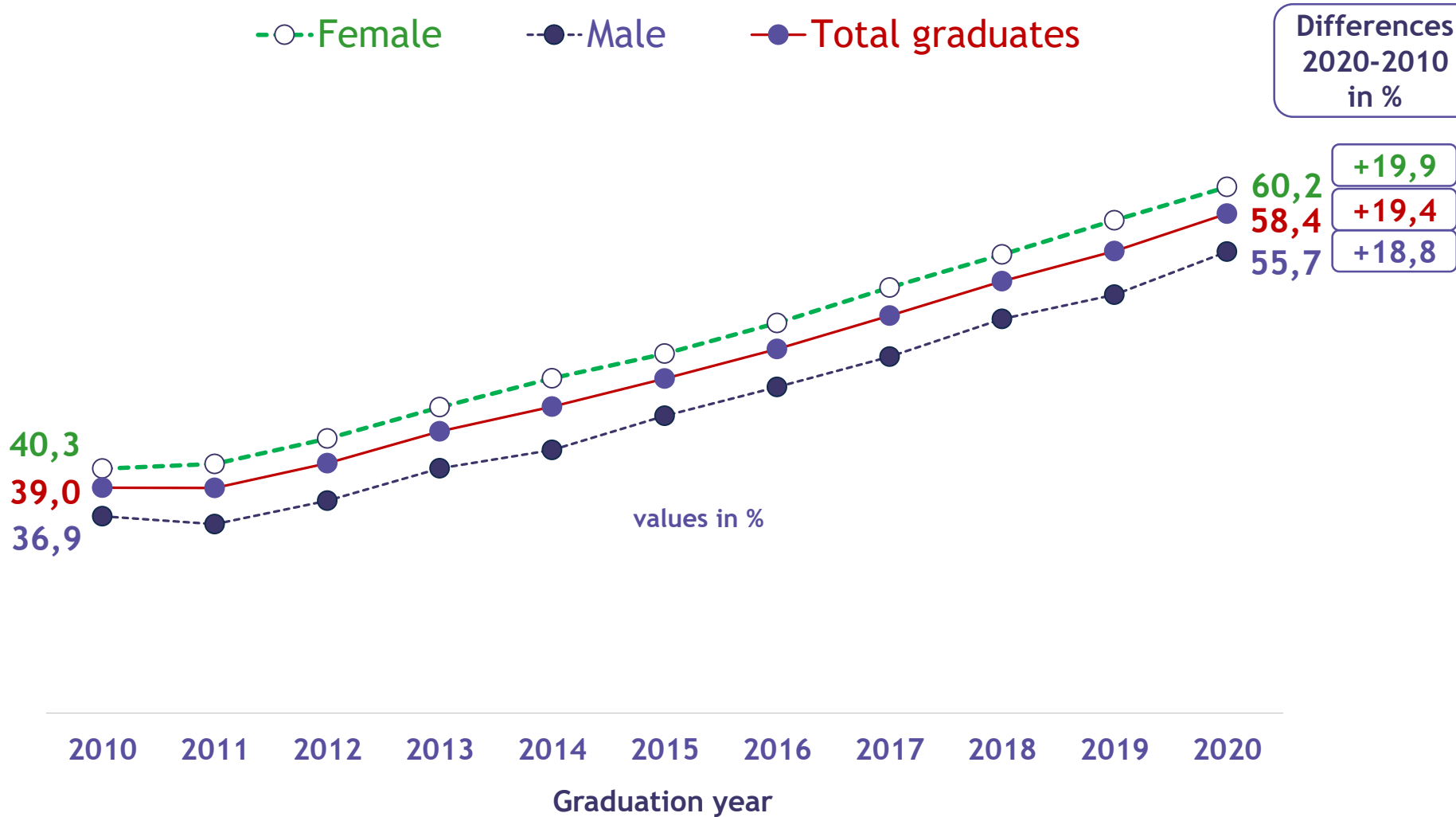


Experience during studies (2020 graduates)



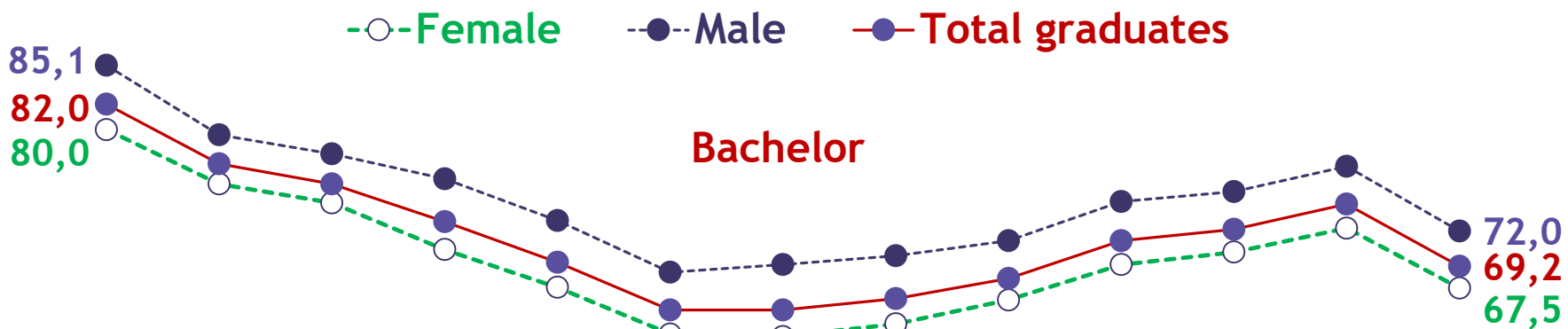


Regularity of studies





Employment rate: 2007 - 2019 graduates

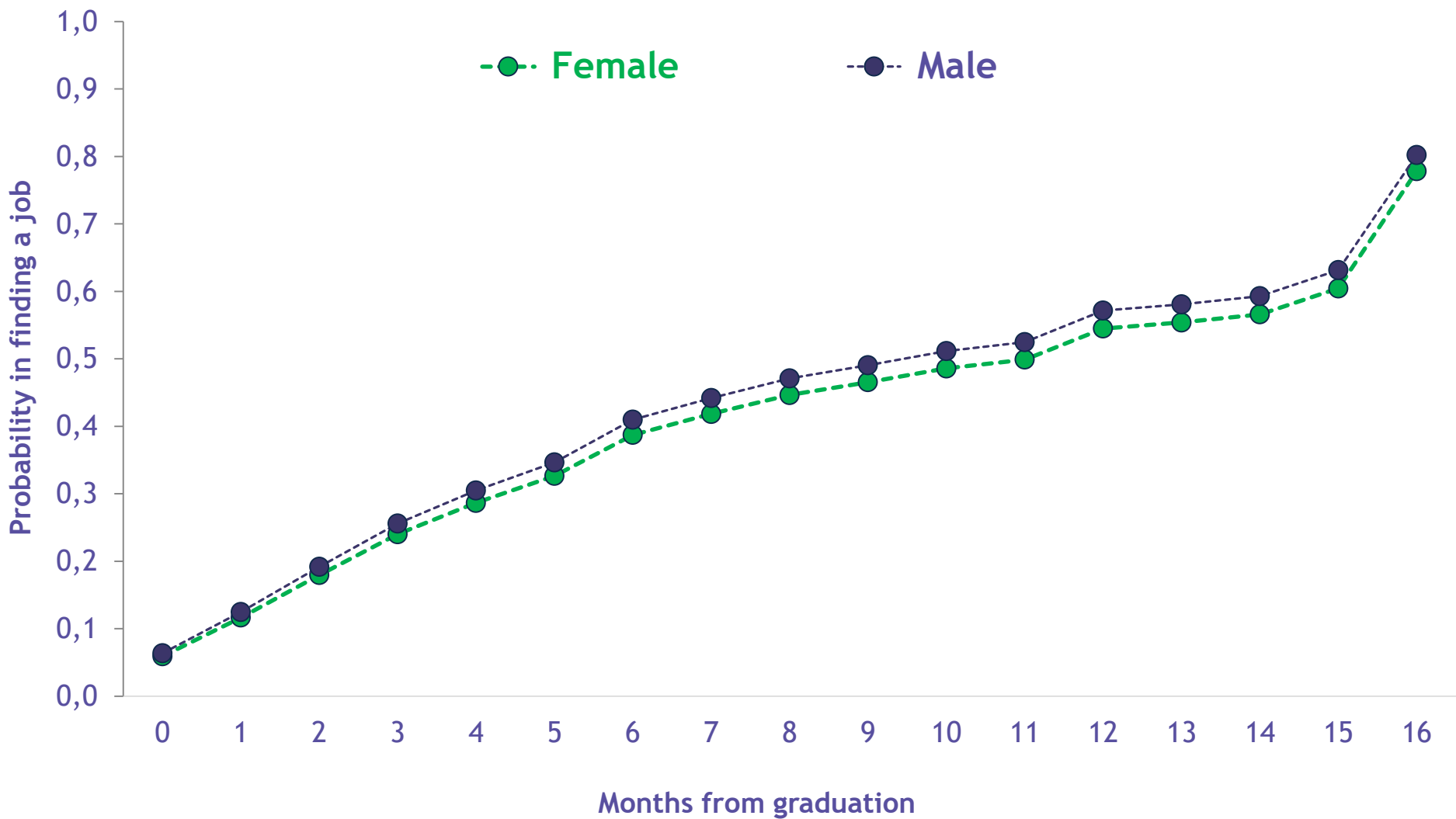

2019 graduates: time spent to enter in labour market

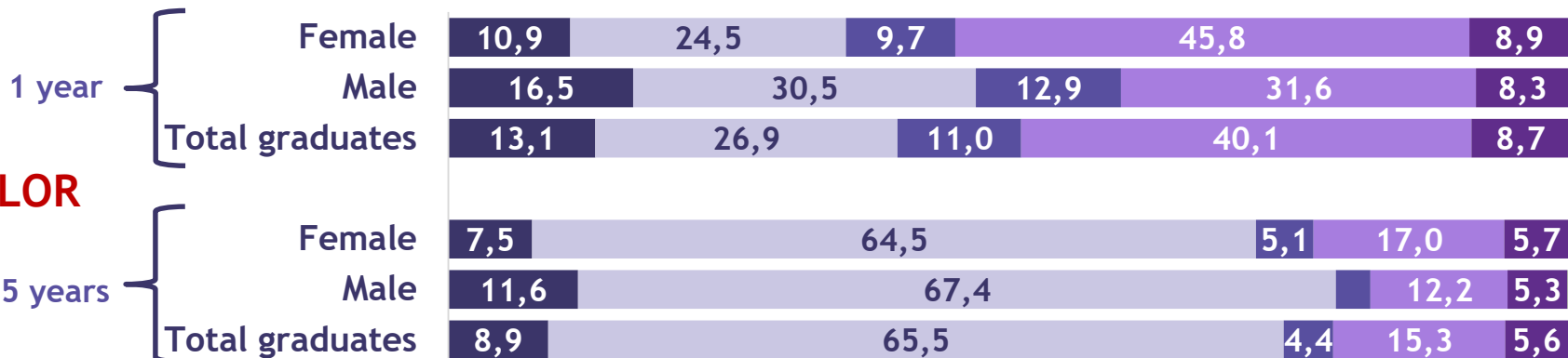




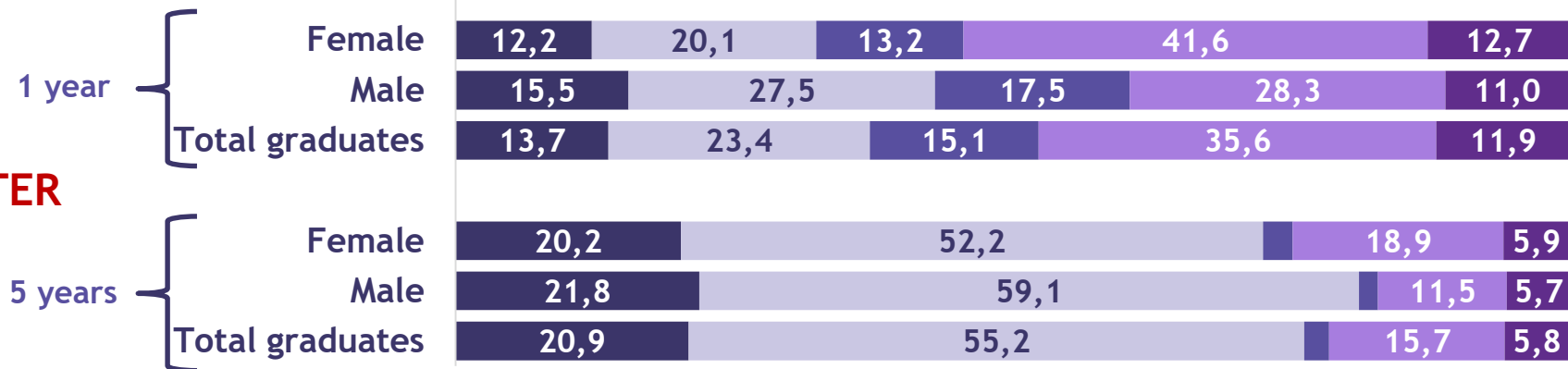
2019 and 2015 graduates: Job activity type performed

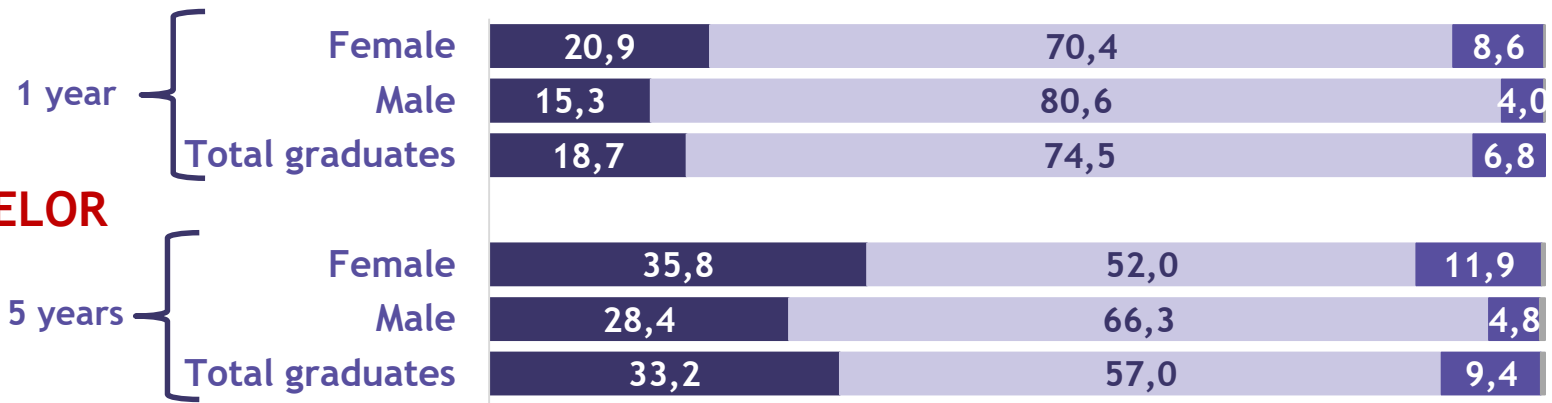

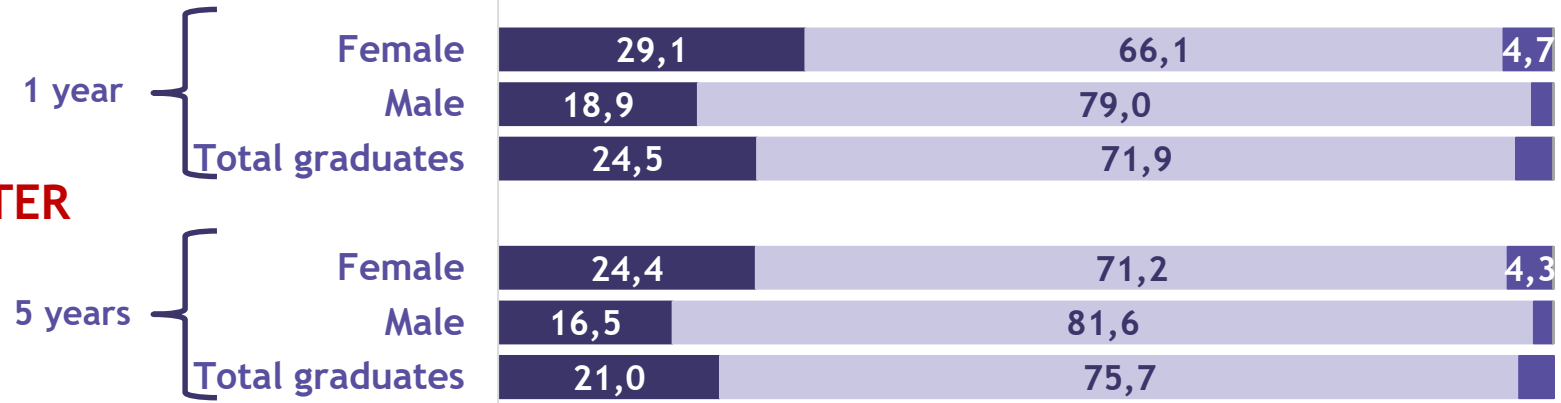


2019 and 2015 graduates: sector of jobs

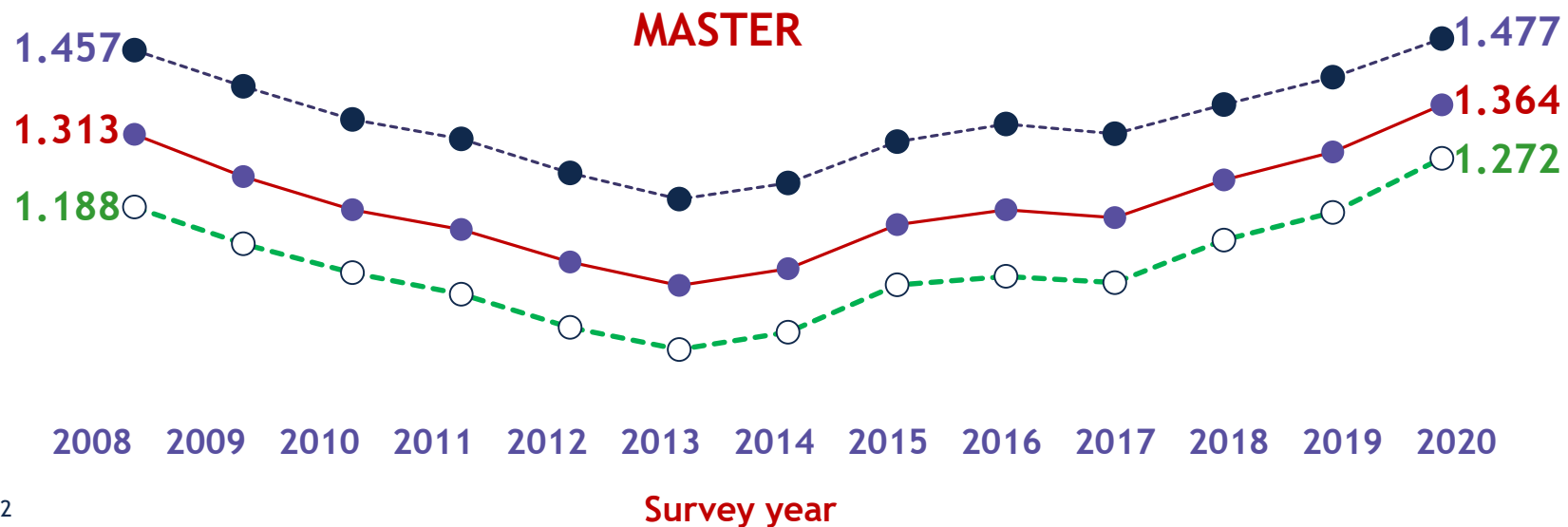
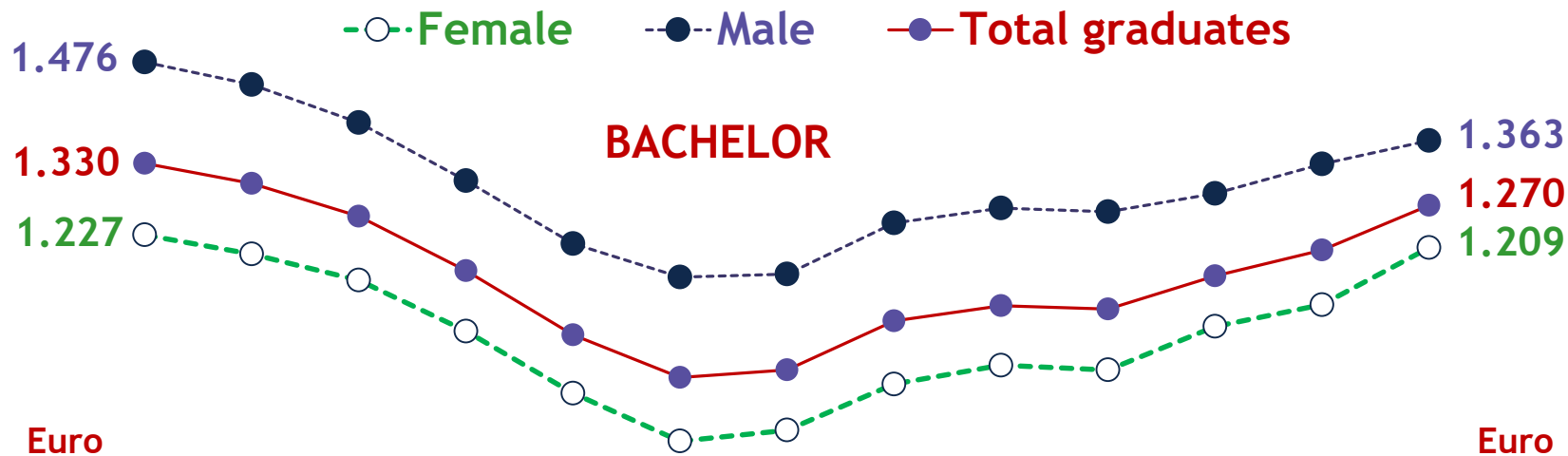

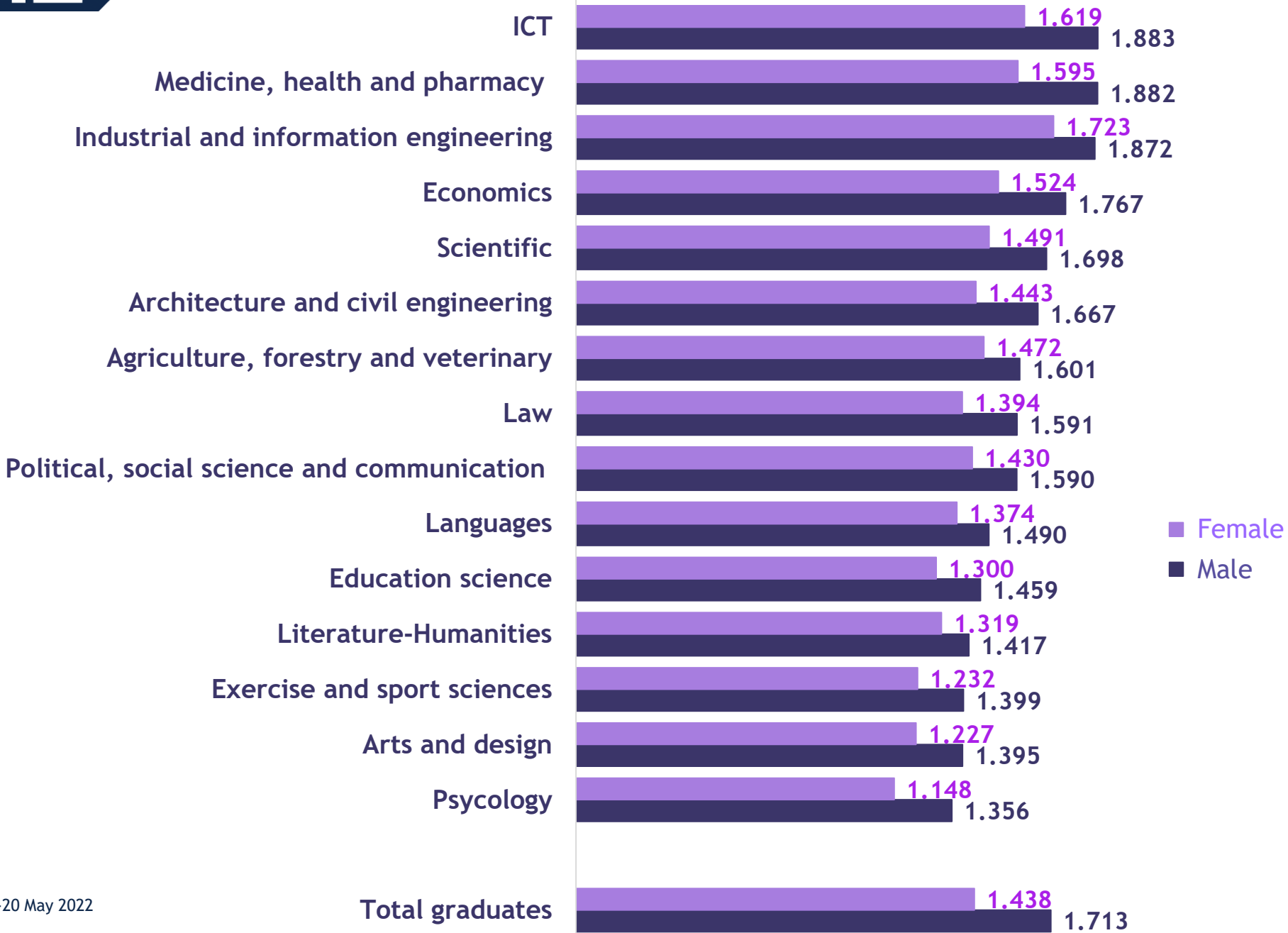
Graduates net earnings/month at one year after graduation

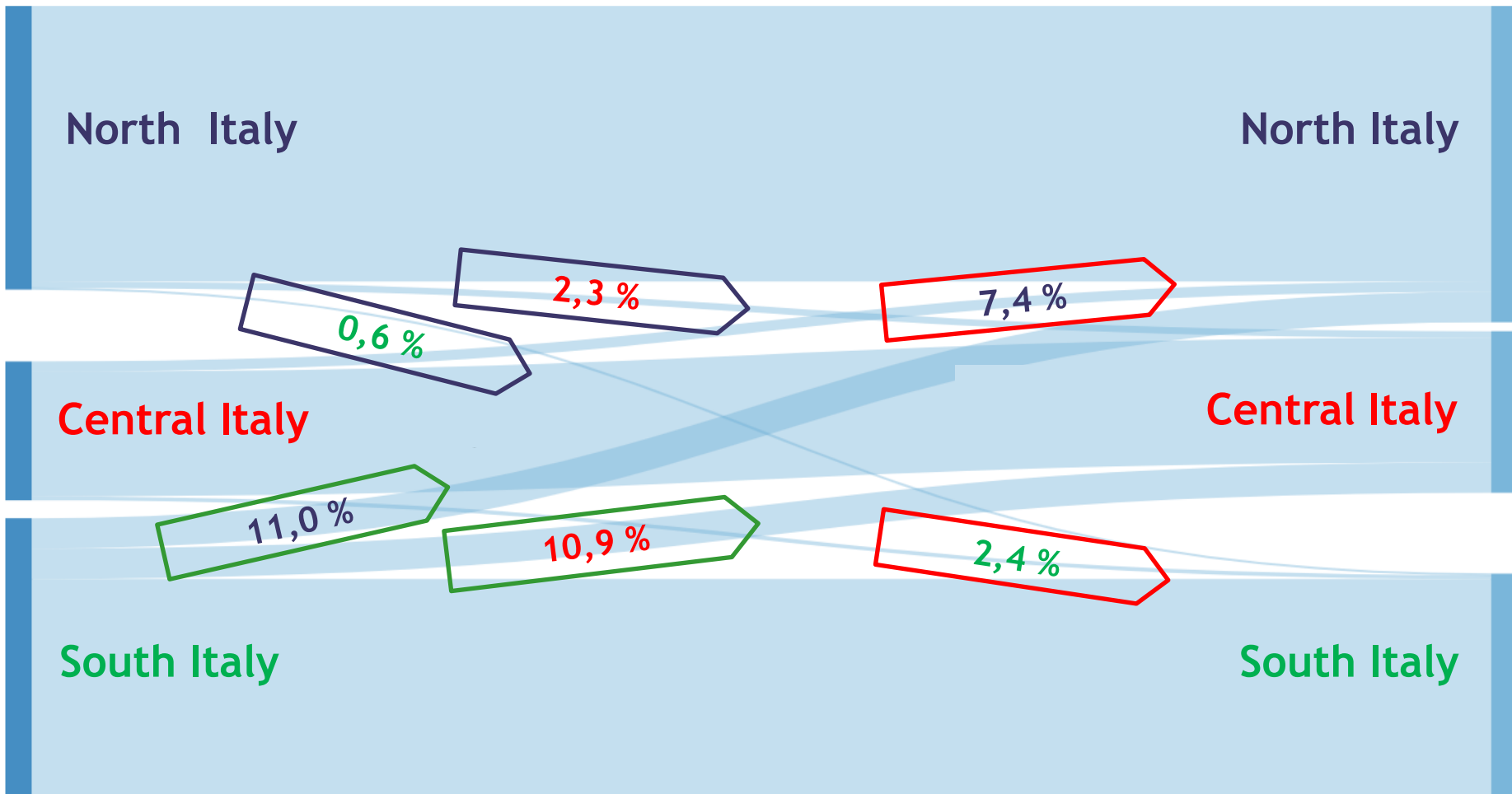

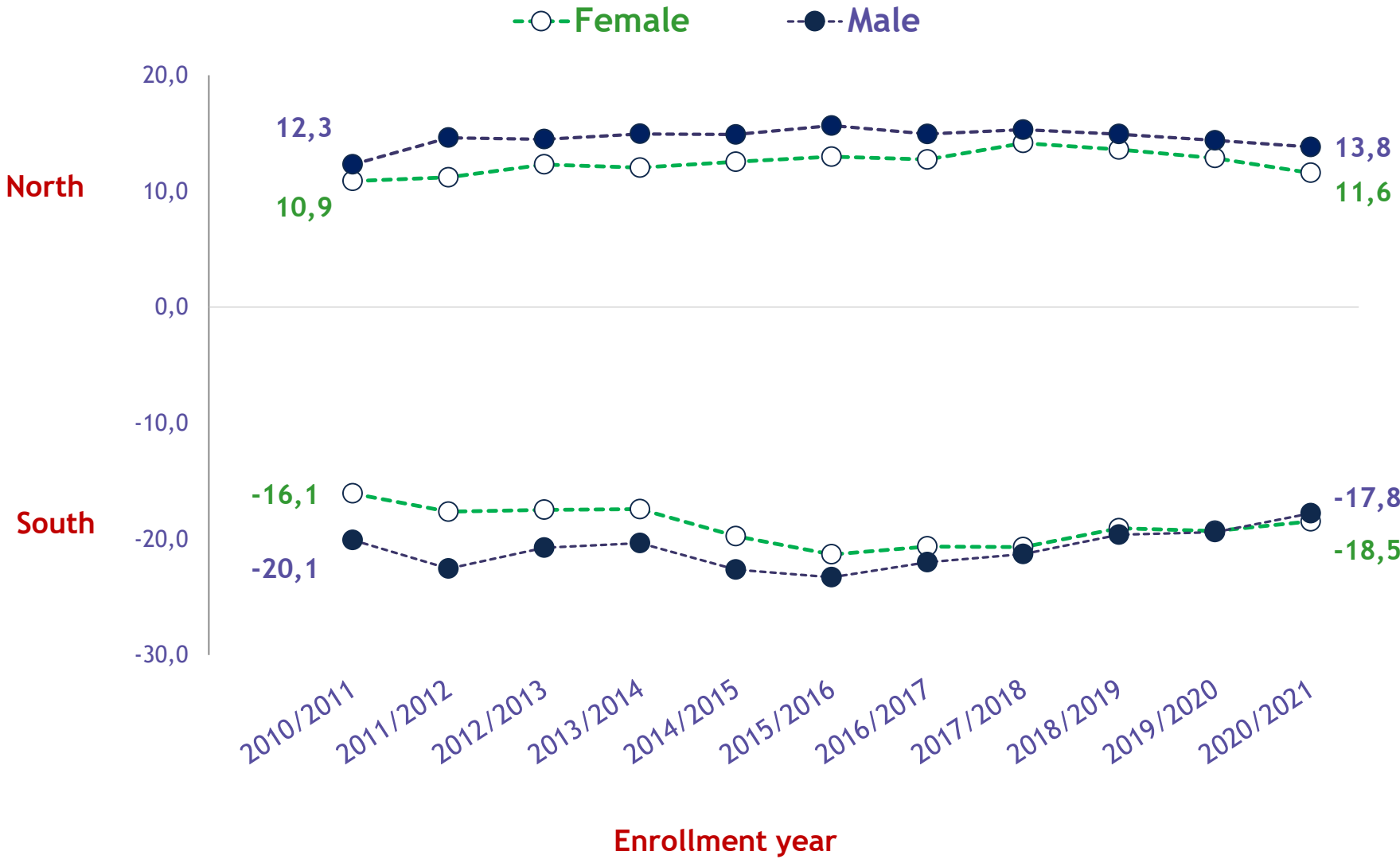

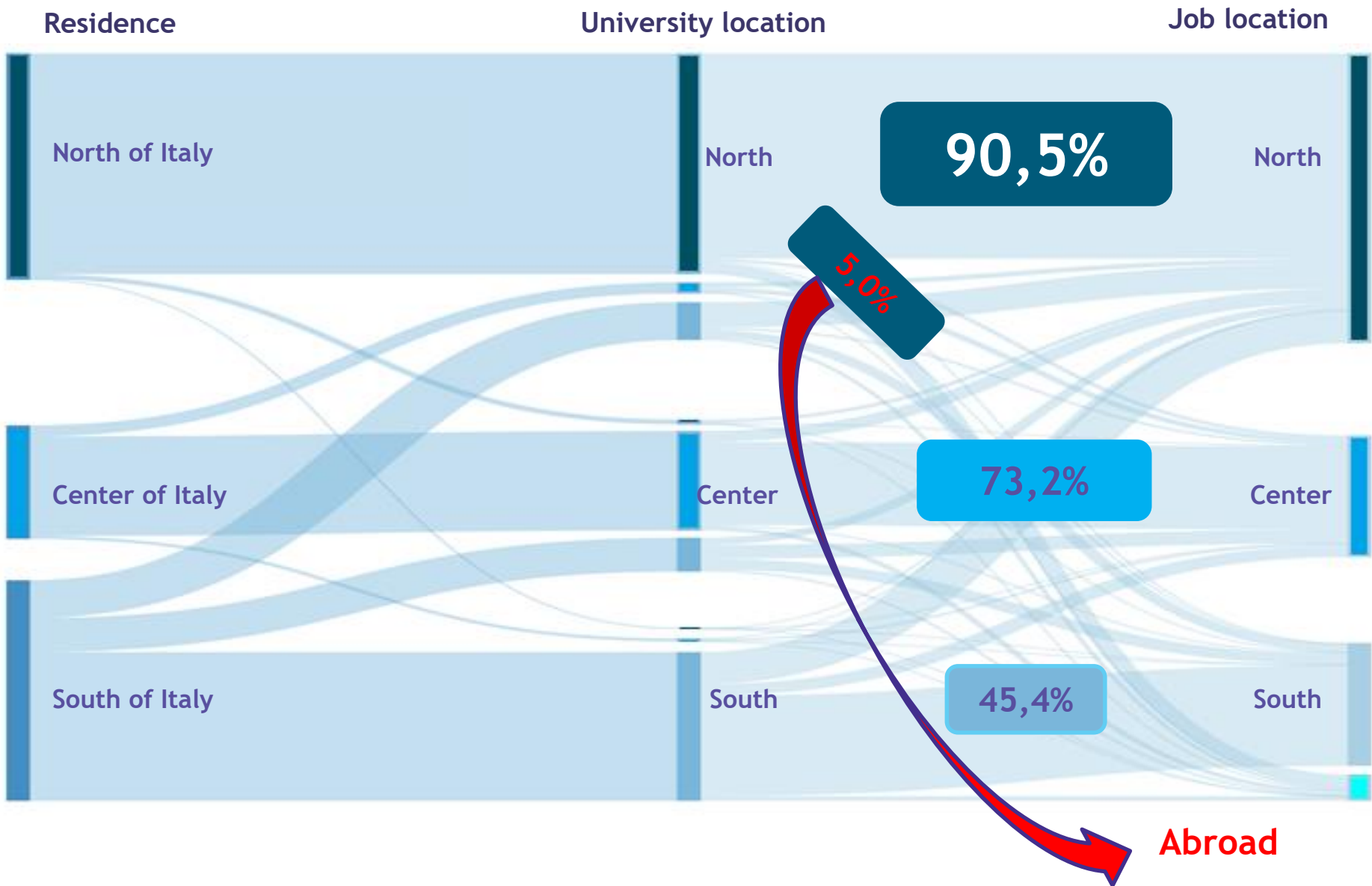


2010-2020 enrolled students: North/South students migration in %





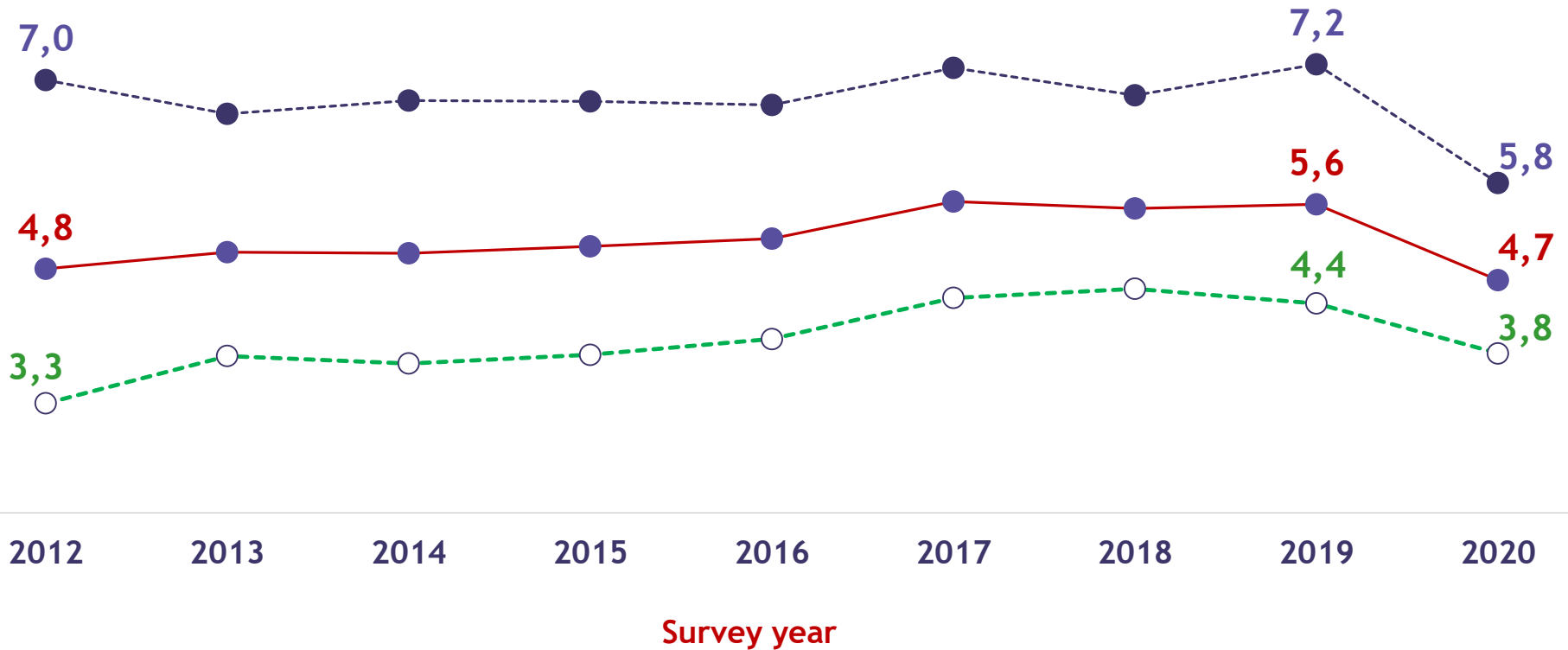
2015 Masters graduates, employed at 5 years after graduation: mobility for study and work





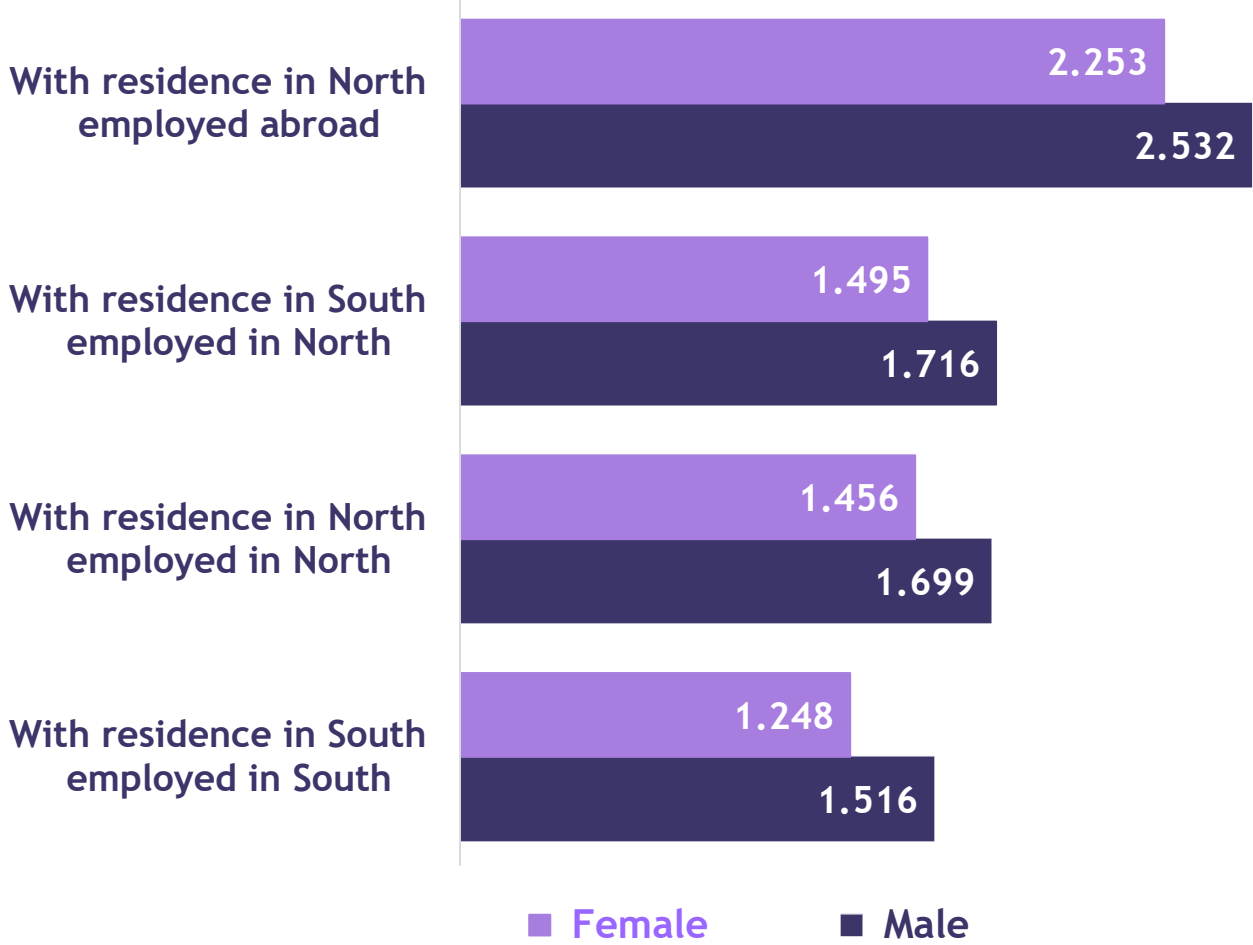
2007-2015 Master level graduates' employment rate at 5 years after graduation: % employed abroad
